$$\begin{aligned} -2x + 4y &= -8 \\ -2(2) + 4(-1) &= -8 \\ -4 + -4 &= -8 \\ -8 &= -8 \end{aligned}$$
$$\begin{aligned} 3x + y &= 5 \\ 3(2) + -1 &= 5 \\ 6 - 1 &= 5 \\ 5 &= 5 \end{aligned}$$
