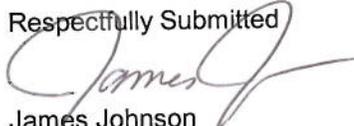
1. Annual Meeting- 13 May 2008 at 1800L, Speaker and 20 min. movie on the Wall.

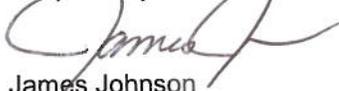

Old Business:

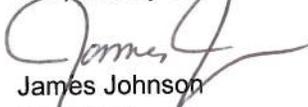
1. Minutes from previous meeting were read and approved.

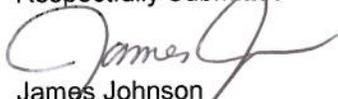

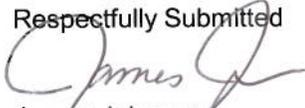

4. Heritage Fund Account: Possibly move funds to Alumni Acct. if we can't get Bank to stop charging monthly fees.

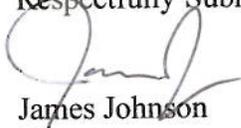
