1. Go to the [Georgia 4-H Camp & Event Registration Site](#)
2. Create a user account -- the account creation procedure is a 3 part process
 1. Select 'Create Account for Parent' from the left hand menu and fill out the form. You will receive an email with an account activation code.
 2. Click the link included in the email and paste the code into the form.
 3. Enter your preferred password
3. Select the appropriate event.
4. Be sure to click the insert link on the left hand menu to get to the application form.
5. Also, note that more than one participant can apply using the same account
