SUBJECT: 19 November 2013 106 RQW Alumni Association Meeting Minutes

1. The 106 RQW Alumni Association board met on 19 November 2013 in the Maintenance Group Quality Assurance Conference Room. The following personnel attended:

2. CMSgt Lamiroult provided the board members with an update concerning the wing. Main topics of discussion were: base entry project, the location of the brick memorial, removal of the F-102, the new airpark, the Bronze Star award ceremony and the 2014 scholarship process.
  - a. Base entry project is completed and is open. A small in-house ribbon cutting ceremony was done opening the gate.
  - b. The F-102 has been removed. Discussions are ongoing as to where the new airpark will be located. The base is receiving (3) large scale models of the HC-130, HH-60 and F-102. A possible location will be near the HH-3 static display as you enter the base. The base will finalize the location in the near future. The models are due to arrive on or about 18 December 2013.
  - c. Memorial brick project was discussed as well. We will hold off to see where the airpark will be located and make a decision as to where the bricks will go. If the aircraft models are not going to go where the F-102 was previously located, the board will most likely go back to the Bldg 345 walkway entrance location if the wing leadership concurs. It was discussed that no one will probably see the bricks in the airpark if it is located off the entrance roadway. The board will work with the wing on the final location and an installation plan after the wing has its May inspection.
  - d. Several PJ's and CRO's will be presented the Bronze Star medal for heroic actions in Afghanistan. If anyone is interested in attending, the ceremony will be held on Friday, 6 December at 1400 in Hangar B. Please contact CMSgt Randy Lamiroult if you are interested.
