SPECIALTY SUMMARY

Advises and assists the Commander in managing unit activities, and exercises general supervision over assigned enlisted personnel. Provides guidance to assigned enlisted personnel on matters of leadership, military courtesy, personal appearance, self-discipline, and personal adherence to standards. Promotes welfare, morale and health of enlisted personnel. Advises Commander on status of unit morale and welfare. Promotes unit recreation and social programs. Counsels enlisted personnel and takes action to resolve problems or complaints. Helps enlisted personnel adapt to military environment and adjust to the organization and duty assignment. Monitors unit administration. Perform other tasks as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS AND SELECTION FACTORS:

- Selection for this position will be made without regard to race, religion, color, creed, gender, or national origin
- The requirements and qualifications prescribed in this announcement are the minimum.
- Selection is not assured merely by meeting these requirements.

OTHER QUALIFICATIONS:

Must be a promotable Master Sergeant, to be promotable to SMSgt, must have 2 years time in grade, and have completed 13 years of time in service. **Must have completed the SNCO Academy, in-residence or correspondence.** **Must hold a 8F000 AFSC.** Master Sergeants who are selected must be promoted immediately upon assuming the position of first sergeant. Must be able to pass Air Force (Active Duty) Physical Fitness Test with an 80 or higher on their last two Fitness Examinations or a 90 or higher on their current Fitness Examination to apply. Must possess good leadership and management skills. Must have the ability to communicate effectively and distinctly in small and large forums. Must possess good administrative skills. Must be computer literate. Must have knowledge of military training, Air Force organization, drill and ceremonies, customs and courtesies, military justice, and counseling techniques. Must have current Commander's endorsement and a **minimum ASVAB Score of A41 or G62.**

INTERVIEW:

An Interviewing Board will be scheduled for all qualified applicants. Applicants will be notified of date and times.

KNOWLEDGE:

Knowledge is mandatory of: personnel management with emphasis on quality force indicators, personnel, and administration; military training; Air Force organization; drill and ceremonies; customs and courtesies; sanitation and hygiene; military justice; and counseling techniques.
