SPECIALTY SUMMARY

Includes nurse midwives, nurse anesthetists, and nurse practitioners. Provides professional nursing care within scope of practice, established standards of care and federal/state laws. Acts as patient advocate and advances desired health outcomes through patient/family education. Coordinates with and makes recommendations to staff agencies concerning applicable policies, plans and programs.

QUALIFICATIONS AND SELECTION FACTORS:

- Selection for this position will be made without regard to race, religion, color, creed, gender, or national origin.
- Applicants are subject to review by the FSS and if mandatory requirements are met, as outlined in applicable regulations, applicants must meet an Officer Screening and Interview Board (OSIB)
- The requirements and qualifications prescribed in this announcement are the minimum for nomination for appointment consideration. Appointment is not assured merely by meeting these requirements. Persons considered must further qualify with requirements outlined in applicable regulations

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Applicant must be less than 47 years of age at time of initial appointment and must satisfactorily complete an appointment physical.

MANDATORY SCHOOL & TRAINING:

Education. A master's or doctoral degree in the suffixed specialty from an accredited program with specialty board certification or For award of AFSC 46Y1A/B/C/G/H/M/P, full time enrollment in an AFIT-funded or Health Profession's Scholarship Program graduate level accredited program

EDUCATION:

Minimum of 6 months full-time nursing practice in the APRN specialty is required. Member must have at least 12 months experience as a registered nurse which MAY INCLUDE the 6 months as a privileged practitioner.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Advanced Practice Registered Nurse. Possess an advanced academic degree in selected nursing specialties for entry into practice. Independent privileged health care provider who uses clinical judgment to render direct patient care, including comprehensive health assessment, differential diagnoses, plans and prescribes pharmacologic and non-pharmacologic treatment in management of acute and chronic conditions, promotes health, and delivers preventive care within the specialized area of practice. Sub-roles include patient and staff education, research, and consultation to promote wellness and prevent illness and injury.
- Includes nurse midwives, nurse anesthetists, and nurse practitioners. Provides professional nursing care within scope of practice, established standards of care and federal/state laws. Acts as patient advocate and advances desired health outcomes through patient/family education. Coordinates with and makes recommendations to staff agencies concerning applicable policies, plans and programs.

KNOWLEDGE:

Knowledge of principles and practices of nursing is mandatory.

EXPERIENCE:

For non-AFIT and non-HPSP trained APRNs, award of AFSCs 46YXX, must be approved by the Nurse Corps Development Team.

OSIB:

An Officer Screening and Interviewing Board (OSIB) will convene to interview all qualified applicants. Applicants will be informed in writing, or telephonically, of date and time to appear.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES:

Applicants will prepare and forward one copy of the AF Form 24, Application of Appointment as Reserve of the Air Force or USAF Without Component, Copy of AFOQT Scores, Resume, Current Official College Transcripts, Record of Separation/Discharge from the US Armed Forces (if applicable), and a Records Review RIP (if applicable).
