



The New York National Guard Family Readiness Council, Inc (NYNGFRC) is pleased to announce the awarding of two of \$1000 College Scholarships for the 2016-2017 academic year. The Scholarships may be used for expenses incurred while attending an accredited college or university.

These Scholarships will be awarded to children or spouses of the New York Organized Militia who meet the eligibility requirements. Once they complete an application and provide other required information, they will be considered for a Scholarship.

In order to be eligible to receive a scholarship, you must meet the following requirements:

- Be a dependent unmarried child under the age of 23 of a member of the New York Organized Militia **OR**
- The spouse of a member of the New York Organized Militia
- Be a graduating high school senior attending an accredited college or university in Fall 2016 **OR**
- Be enrolled at an accredited college or university returning Fall 2016
- Be enrolled in DEERS (Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System) and have a current ID card
- Provide a completed Scholarship Application and required enclosures by May 1, 2016.
- You may not be attending a service academy or prep school.
