Credentials:

- High School Senior (Male or Female).
- 80% or better cumulative average.
- Accepted for matriculation in a two or four year degree program at a regionally accredited College or University anywhere in the United States.
- Demonstrate involvement in school related extra-curricular activities or community service (certificates, letters, articles accepted to confirm participation).

Requirements: If you are eligible for one of these grants you may apply by providing the following:

- This completed application including the Student Profile Parts A through D
- An official transcript of student's high school record.
- One or more letters of recommendation from individuals not related to the applicant.
- Copy of parents DD form 214 if applicant is dependent of a retired or honorably discharged Air Force individual.
- Applicants selected for the Grants will submit a copy of the bursar receipt of matriculation from an institution of higher education to receive payment.

Deadline: Completed applications, transcripts and other information must be received by the Scholastic Grant committee no later than June of each year.
